Recognised as one of the world's largest metro rail initiatives under a [public-private partnership \(PPP\)](#) model, HMR's story has been featured in the Harvard Business publishing platform. The study, titled "Hyderabad Metro – From Concept to

Execution: The World's Largest Metro Rail Project under Public-Private Partnership", was authored by professors and researchers from the Indian School of Business (ISB). It explores the project's journey from inception to execution, detailing the numerous challenges it faced and the strategies adopted to overcome them. According to the study, the project encountered significant hurdles — from initial setbacks and land acquisition issues to public protests, political instability, religious and heritage concerns, and financial constraints. Despite these challenges, HMR evolved into a vital [urban transportation](#) system and became a globally recognised example of successful [infrastructure development](#) through the PPP model. 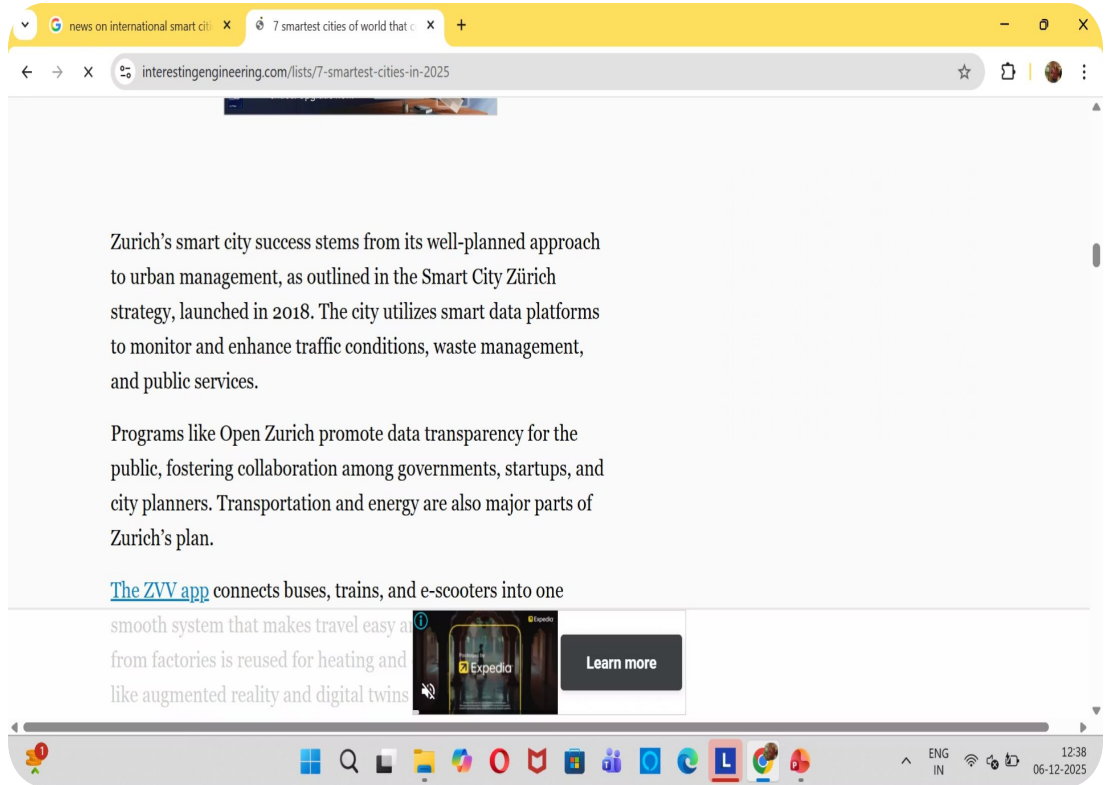

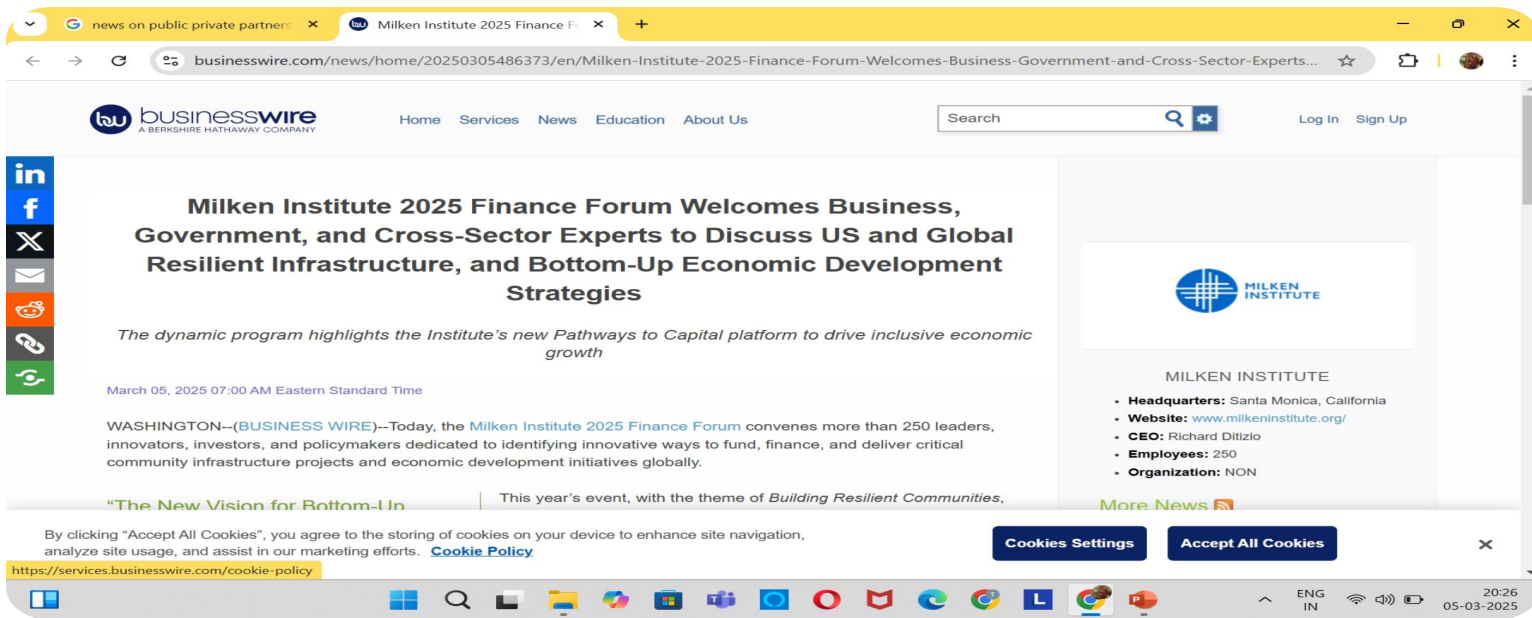

TSA eGates public-private partnership enhances traveler experience

WASHINGTON—New electronic gates (eGates) are debuting at TSA security checkpoints to help expedite identity verification in select airports, thanks to a new TSA public-private partnership.

The eGates allow TSA to automatically compare traveler biometrics with their identity document and boarding pass without the need for a human operator, enhancing efficiency and security. CLEAR, a private company operating under TSA's Registered Traveler Program, is conducting an operational assessment of these specific eGates in coordination with TSA at no cost to U.S. taxpayers.

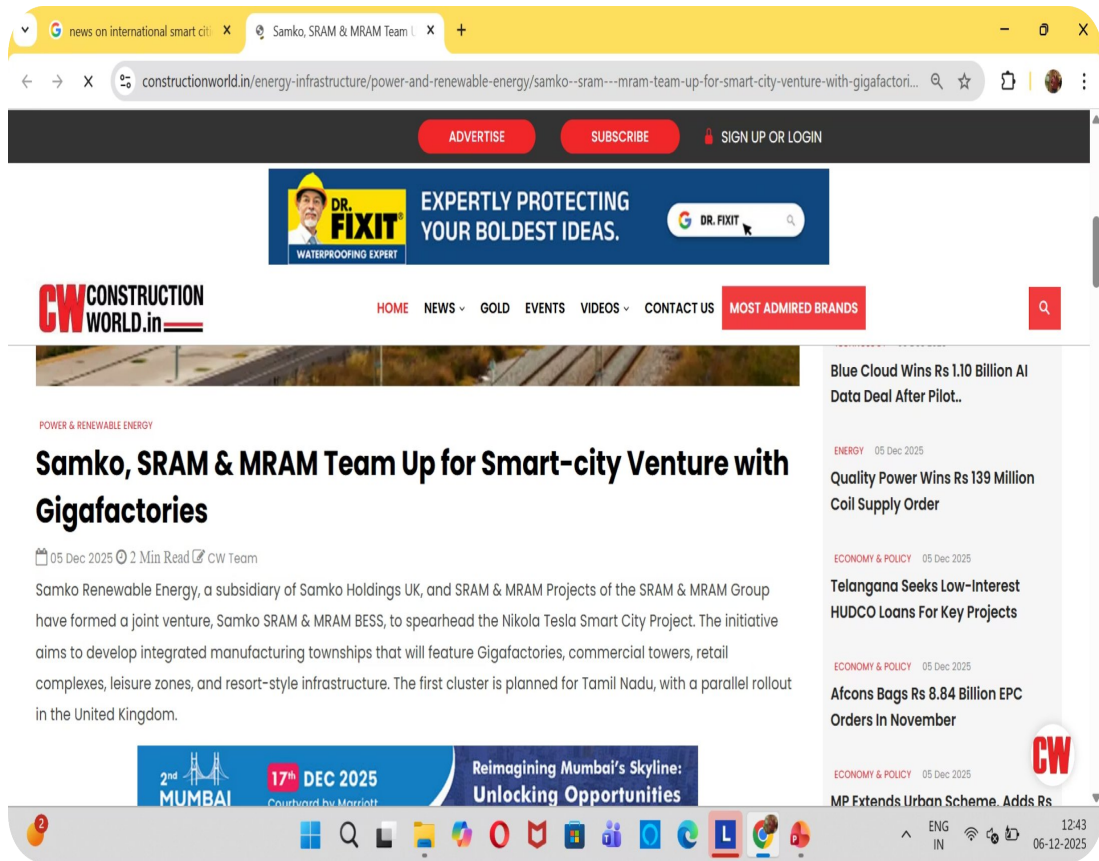

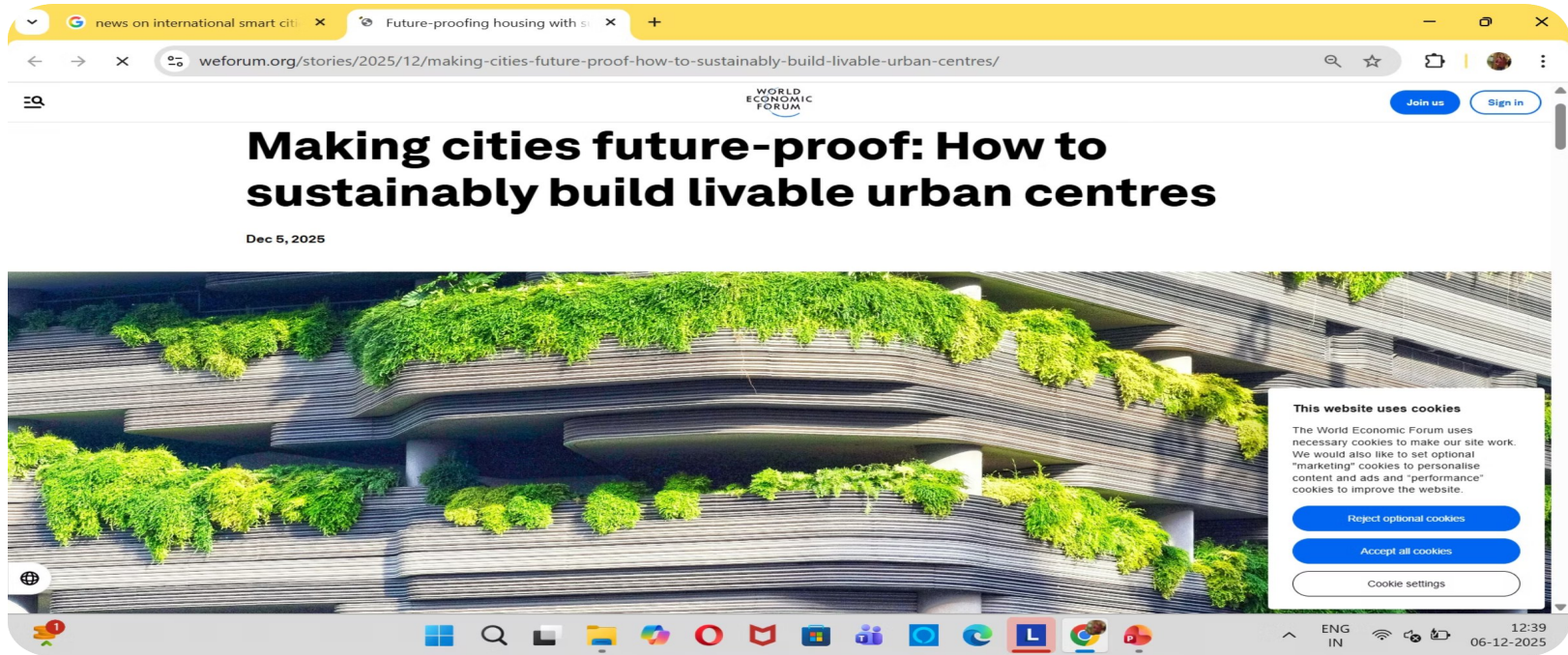
